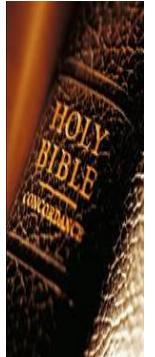
### Hands-On Mission Project to Liberia and Zimbwe

Food buckets will be picked up on June 8, 2012 at a designated location which will be announced. Items listed below need to be packed in a new 5 gallon bucket with a lid.

- 1-5lb bag of cornmeal
- 1-5lb bag of Sugar
- 1-5lb bag of self-rising flour
- 1-2lb bag of rice
- 1-2lb bag dried beans
- 1 box tea bags (24 ct. Take out of box)
- 1 box of powdered Milk (9 oz or less)
- 1 bottle of cooking oil (48 oz or less)
- 1 Small box of Splenda
- 1-2lb (or 2-1lb) canned ham (s)
